Step 1 – Creating an account


- Go to www.padlet.com and sign up.

Step 2 – Creating a wall

- To get started, click Create new padlet.





- Click the Modify Wall button to begin customizing your wall.




- Click on each of the tiles to customize our wall.

	Basic Info	Customize the image associated with the wall, the title of the wall, and the wall description. Use the title and description fields for the questions, topics, assignment, etc.
	Wallpaper	Choose a background image for your wall.
	Layout	Decide how posts will appear on your wall.
	Privacy	Choose how public your wall will be.
	Notifications	Decide if you want to be emailed each time a post is added to your wall.
	Address	Allows you to create a custom URL for your wall.
	Copy	Allows you to duplicate your wall with or without posts, such as a wall for each class period.
	Delete	Allows you to delete a wall.

Step 3 – Adding posts to a wall



- ← Add your name or title.
- ← Add your text response.
- ← Add a link (webpage, video, image), upload an image, or take a photo using a web cam.



- ← Use these tools to edit or delete your post.
- Click your note to move it around on the screen.

Step 4 – Sharing with others


- Click on the  to view the share and export options

SHARE: You can share your wall with others via social media

EXPORT: You can export the contents of your wall via PDF, Excel, or CSV. (This is a great feature for evaluating student work.)

EMBED: Copy the code to add the padlet to your blog or website.

MOBILIZE: Invite other to collaborate by sharing the URL or the QR code!
